



Did you know you can play squash as a casual member?

How to book a court

Go-to Melbourn Squash Clubs Webpage <https://melbourn-squash.club>

Press the tab "Join as a casual member"

Enter your name, email address and select the "Open Pay As You Go Account" tab

You will receive an email with a link to the "Set/Reset your password" which will take you to a page where you can begin the password creation process. Enter your email address and press the Email link tab. You will then receive another email containing another link. This time the link will take you to the Reset Password page where you need to create a password and log in

Once logged in you can book courts (go-to "Bookings") up to 2 days in advance but only at times when the Sports Centre is open

The cost for casual members is £13.50 per session and lasts 40 minutes. Note that if you arrive early and the preceding court is empty, you can increase your play time to up to 50 minutes free of charge! Ask reception for details.

You will need to purchase credit to use as payment for your booking. You can use a credit/debit card or your PayPal account if you have one. You will be redirected to the top-up page once you "confirm" your booking. You will need to purchase at least £13.50 of credit to pay for your game

Please note that for the lights to operate you will need to make a note of the Light Control Code – this code is required to turn on the lights when you arrive to play. Session start and end times are strictly controlled by an electronic light controller - if you arrive late, you will not get your full 40 minutes of squash

Go-to "Your Bookings" and download the "Court Booking Guide" or ask a member of staff at the Sports Centre desk for help to turn the lights on

To enter the squash club, please ask the Sports Centre and they will let you in

PLEASE NOTE: NON-MARKING, CLEAN FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN WHILST PLAYING SQUASH. WITHOUT THE CORRECT SHOES YOU CANNOT PLAY. THANK YOU FOR YOUR COOPERATION
